4. TO RECEIVE money and grant receipt thereof for and to do all other acts and things which may be necessary to be done for the progress and in the course of the prosecution of the said cause.
5. TO ENGAGE Instruct any other legal practitioner authorizing him to exercise the power and authority herby conferred on the Advocates whenever the may think fir to do so
 AND I/WE hereby agree that whatever the Advocate (s) or his/their substitute shall do in the premises shall be binding on me in all intents and purposes just as if it would have been done by me.

AND I/WE herby agree to ratify whatever the Advocates or their substitutes/s responsible for the result of the said case in consequence of his absence from the court when the said case in called up for hearing.

AND I/WE hereby agree that in the event of the whole or any part of the free agreed by me us to be paid to the Advocate (s) remaining unpaid he/they shall be entitled to withdraw from the prosecution of the said case, or not to appear until the same is paid.
